We would like to invite you to a Year 2 drop-in session at 2:15pm on Thursday 23rd October to celebrate the launch of NumBots in our classrooms!

NumBots is an engaging online maths platform designed to help children develop confidence, fluency and understanding in number and calculation. Through fun, interactive challenges, children practise key mathematical skills and build their number sense step by step. Most importantly, it encourages them to show resilience, determination and a positive learning attitude as they progress through each level.

During the drop-in, you'll have the opportunity to:

- See the children actively using NumBots in class
- Watch how they approach challenges with focus and perseverance
- Find out how you can support your child at home with their NumBots learning

To celebrate the fantastic effort the children are putting in, we have recently introduced rewards for regular home reading:

- **5 reads in a week** – a sticker and name up on zone board
- **6 and 7 reads in a week** – name to top of zone board, Cheeky Charlie stamp and prize from prize box

Each **Friday**, we will count the number of reads completed from the highlighted line in the reading record from the previous week. Please note that we can only accept **one read per day** as we want to encourage regular reading little and often which makes the biggest difference to fluency and progress.

Children are reminded that they may change their reading books **every morning and at the end of the day** giving them choice and ownership over their reading. We do recommend that each book is read at least three times to support decoding, fluency and comprehension.

Thank you again for your continued support in helping to nurture a love of reading at home. Working together, we can make a huge difference for your child.
