Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to let you know about an exciting day trip to Stubbington Study Centre that we are organising for the children of Year 4. The trip is scheduled to take place on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2025, and we feel that it would greatly enhance their topic work for this term.

This year, in History, we will be studying the Anglo Saxons. Whilst at Stubbington, the children will have the opportunity to take part in a workshop. The experience takes place in a replica longhouse, which is a very atmospheric space and gives children the idea of what it might be like to be a thane in the Anglo-Saxon Era.

In addition, the children will also take part in an Earthquake simulation experience which will support them when we study earthquakes later this year as part of our Geography work.

Unfortunately, due to the ever-increasing costs for visits, we are asking parents for a contribution of £11.50 towards this workshop. The school has already subsidised some of the cost. Please make payment through the Arbor app by Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2025.

## Details about the day:

- Please could you ensure that your child arrives at school early on the day of the trip. If you could arrange for them to be in school by 08:30, that will help us to leave promptly and arrive at Stubbington at the correct time.

## Clothing:

To make the most of the day, it is important that your child is comfortable and suitably dressed for the outdoors. Stubbington's website says, 'there's no such thing as bad weather, only bad clothing'. Children should wear school t-shirts and jumpers as normal but can wear appropriate trousers and footwear. See kit list below:

- A waterproof coat with a hood. Part of the trip will be outside even if it is raining.
- Wear layers of clothing that can be put on or taken off depending on the temperature outside.
- Long trousers. This is a requirement if children are working in the conservation area as this is protection against ticks.
- Warm hat and gloves.
- Walking shoes or trainers with good grip.
- Long hair tied back.
- Earrings removed or covered with medical tape.

We hope that your child enjoys this experience.
