We listen to each child read on a daily basis to support not only their decoding but understanding of what they have read. We also support each child with their High Frequency Words (HFW) as this helps them recognise them by sight and enables them to read more fluently and focus on more complex

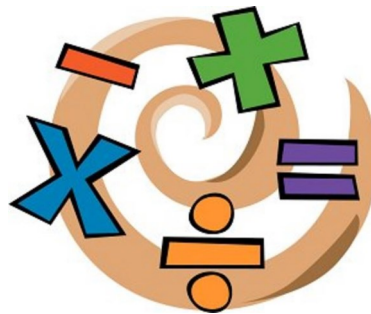


Phonics

In June, children have a Phonics Screening. This short screening assesses the children's phonic decoding and blending skills, the words included are real and alien words. Children need to sound out a word and then read it to their teacher.

On a daily basis the children will develop their key maths skills - problem solving, reasoning, and fluency as well as teaching them to be confident

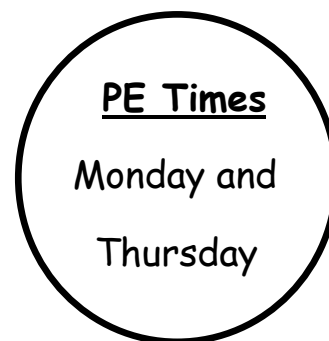
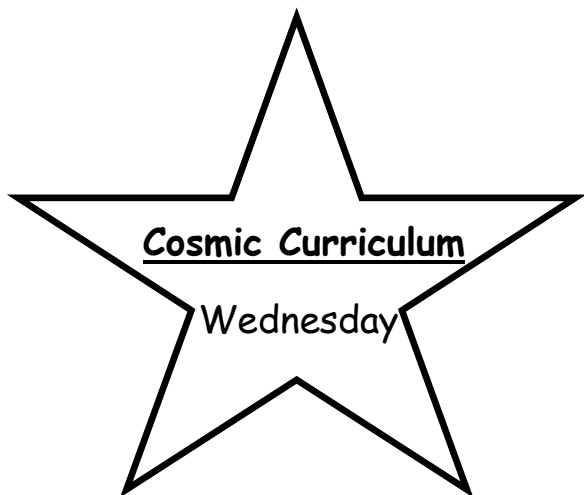


Home Learning
