## Sports Premium Funding – Plan for 2018-19



Warren Park is a two form primary school with a strong sporting tradition. Having recently received a School Games Gold Award, Warren Park aim to continue this tradition and further increase participation, mastery and teacher development. This academic year, the school have accounted for £19400.

### PE BUDGET OBJECTIVES

- To continue to improve the quality of teaching and diversity of the PE curriculum in order for all pupils to make regular and sustained progress.
- To use physical activity to improve children's health, well-being and educational outcomes.
- To use PE, School Sport and physical activities/exercise to impact on whole school goals and targets.
